Lake Granbury Youth Services provides detention and secure residential treatment programming for up to 95 pre- and post-adjudicated youth. Individualized services address treatment issues and their relationship to criminal conduct behaviors. We offer services for pre-adjudicated youth ages 10-17 and schooling for post-adjudicated youth from 5th through 12th grades. Other program features include:

- A prosocial culture within a safe and nurturing milieu which sets the stage for youth success
- Specialized trauma-informed programming for youth with histories of trauma, sexual abuse, and human trafficking
- Highly-trained, motivated and culturally-competent staff who are passionate about improving the lives of youth
- Strength-based approaches that utilize innate talents and abilities of youth to achieve lasting change
- Residential treatment services for male and female populations that respond to the unique needs of all genders
- Family engagement throughout every stage of youth treatment and program planning



CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL

Lone Star Success Academy provides year-round education for grades 5 - 12. Other features of the on-site charter school include:

- Accreditation by the Texas Education Agency (TEA)
- Highly qualified, licensed teachers
- Special education, credit recovery and acceleration program
- Stimulating prosocial clubs, including gardening and art
- Youth basketball, volleyball, and weight lifting in our full-size gym, as well as an outdoor track for large-muscle exercise
- Exciting career fields, including: ServSafe Food Handler and Manager Certification; Petroleum Oil and Gas Certification; Weight Training; IADC Rig Pass Training; and Microsoft Office Certification

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Family involvement is critical to youth achievement and change. In order to repair, rebuild, and enhance ties between a youth and their family, Lake Granbury Youth Services provides family services through:

- Participation in treatment planning
- Weekend on-site visitation
- Home passes for youth who have earned their RAM status
- On-site parenting classes utilizing the Active Parenting curriculum
- Video conferencing with families and probation officers

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

We strive to assist youth in reforging connections to their communities by linking them to local resources and providing community service opportunities. Ultimately, we desire youth to be viewed as valuable resources and supports for their communities. Therefore, we partner with local organizations including churches, nursing homes, and city organizers to both connect with and give back to our local community. We also regularly host career days, in which local colleges and military recruiters visit our youth to discuss their many options ahead.



TREATMENT SERVICES

Lake Granbury uses research-validated assessment instruments to evaluate criminogenic risk factors, and uses other emotional and ability assessments to develop a treatment plan for each youth. Treatment services include:

- Individualized Treatment Plan with unique goals and targeted services
- Clinical team specializing in high/moderate needs substance abuse, and moderate mental health needs treatment
- Positive Skill Development groups
- Individual counseling
- Group and family therapy
- Psychological and psychiatric interventions
- Medication management (when necessary)
