2024 ANNUAL REPORT




Lake Granbury Youth Services (LGYS) is a certified secure residential treatment program serving male and female youth with post-adjudication and pre-adjudication services.

The post-adjudication services are provided through a trauma-informed model that includes evidence-based principles to address issues related to substance abuse, mental health, abuse and trauma and their relationship to criminal conduct behaviors.


DEMOGRAPHICS OF YOUTH SERVED

2024 OUTCOMES

- 15 years old was the average age in 2024
- 75% of discharges were successful exits
- 6 hours of education per day
- 8 GEDs awarded
- 8.5 hours of treatment provided per youth each week
- 6.3 average family contacts per youth each month
- 460 family visits hosted
