

College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Goals

2026–2027 Academic Year

In accordance with Texas Education Code (TEC) §11.185 and §11.186, the following College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Goals have been adopted to ensure all students graduate prepared for success beyond high school.

Overall CCMR Goal

Increase graduates meeting at least one CCMR indicator to 75% by June 2027.

College Readiness

Increase graduates meeting TSIA2, SAT, or ACT benchmarks to 60%. Support includes test preparation and academic interventions.

Career Readiness

Increase students earning Industry-Based Certifications to 40%. Includes CTE pathways and certification support.

Military Readiness

Increase graduates meeting military readiness criteria to 10%. Includes ASVAB access and guidance.

Postsecondary Success

Increase graduates enrolling in college or workforce within one year to 70%.

Monitoring & Accountability

100% of juniors and seniors will have individualized CCMR plans with ongoing progress monitoring.
