Lake Granbury Youth Services (LGYS) provides secure residential treatment programming for up to 95 pre- and post-adjudicated male youth. Individualized services address treatment issues and their relationship to criminal conduct behaviors. We offer services for pre-adjudicated youth ages 12 to 17, schooling for post-adjudicated youth from 6th through 12th grades, and a young offenders dorm for ages 11 to 14.

Program features include:

- A pro-social culture within a safe and nurturing environment which sets the stage for youth success
- Highly-trained, motivated and culturally-competent staff who are passionate about improving the lives of youth
- Strengths-based approach toward each youth's abilities to achieve growth and positive change
- Residential treatment services and specialized trauma-informed programming that responds to the unique needs of our youth
- Family engagement throughout every stage of program planning and treatment

Charter High School

Lake Granbury's onsite charter school, Lone Star Success Academy (LSSA), provides year-round education for grades 6 through 12. Features of LSSA include:

- Accreditation by the Texas Education Agency (TEA)
- Pearson Certified GED test center
- Highly qualified, licensed teachers
- Special education, credit recovery and acceleration program
- Pro-social clubs, including gardening and art
- Basketball, volleyball, and weight lifting in our full-size gym, as well as an outdoor track
- CTE opportunities, including ServSafe Food Handler and Manager, First Aid and CPR, and OSHA certifications



Family Engagement

In order to repair, rebuild, and enhance ties between a youth and their family, Lake Granbury provides family services through:

- Participation in treatment planning
- Weekend on-site visitation
- Home passes for youth who have earned their RAM status
- On-site parenting classes utilizing the Active Parenting curriculum
- Video calls with families and probation officers

Community Activities

Lake Granbury provides youth with off site community service opportunities in effort to rebuild their community connections and to be viewed as valuable resources and supports for their local communities. In partnership with Hood County organizations including churches, and nursing homes, Lake Granbury youth can both connect with and give back to the community.

LGYS also regularly hosts career days, where local colleges and military recruiters visit our youth to discuss their career paths.



Treatment Services

Our licensed clinical team specializes in treating moderate mental health needs using research-based assessments to evaluate criminogenic risk factors and other emotional and education assessments to develop a treatment plan for each youth. Treatment services include:

- Individualized treatment plan
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- Positive Skill Development groups
- UCCI substance abuse curriculum (CBI-SU)
- Aggression Replacement Training (ART)
- Aim For Change anti-gun violence curriculum
- Psychological and psychiatric interventions
- Medication management (when necessary)
